

ACROSS EUROPE, ACROSS THE GLOBE, INTO THE STREETS FOR GAZA ON 29 NOVEMBER!

The International anti-war conference is calling on all Palestinian supporters, all peace campaigners, all anti-war activists, all trade unionists to take to the streets for the global day of action for Gaza on 29 November.

This is the United Nations International Day of Solidarity with the Palestinian People, but it requires a real, grassroots mobilisation to turn it into an effective day of mass protest.

Any real and meaningful ceasefire in Gaza can only be attained if continued international pressure prevents the Israeli state, with the complicity of Trump and all governements in Europe, from continued attacks on Palestinians in Gaza and the West Bank. For that to happen Israel must end its continued occupation of more than 50 percent of the territory of Gaza. It must stop starving the population and blocking entry of food and relief materials.

The international anti-war conference, established in Paris in October 2025 by delegates from 19 countries, is issuing a call to support the global mobilisation on 29 November.

The Palestine solidarity movement is a vital part of the wider anti-war movement that aims to challenge the break-neck rearmament of Europe. The money which is being squandered on boosting arms company profits by warmongering governments is much needed for wages, hospitals, schools, and to lift working people out of poverty.

For all these reasons we say: across Europe, across the globe, into the streets on 29 November!
